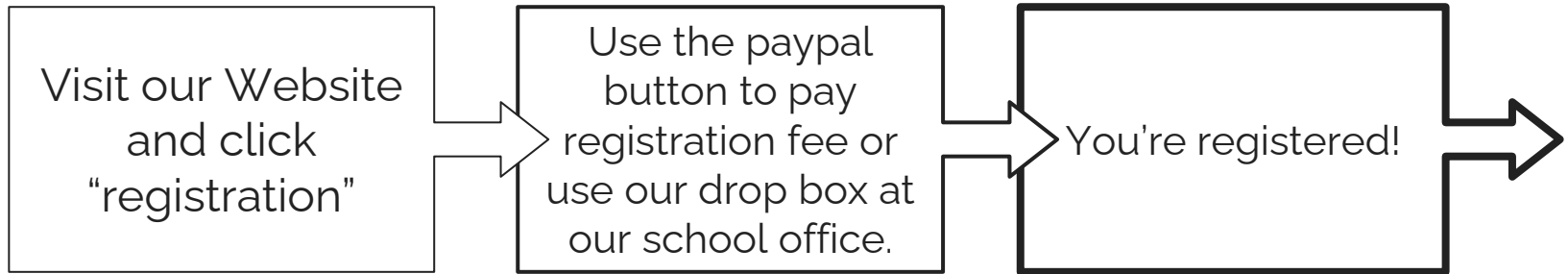

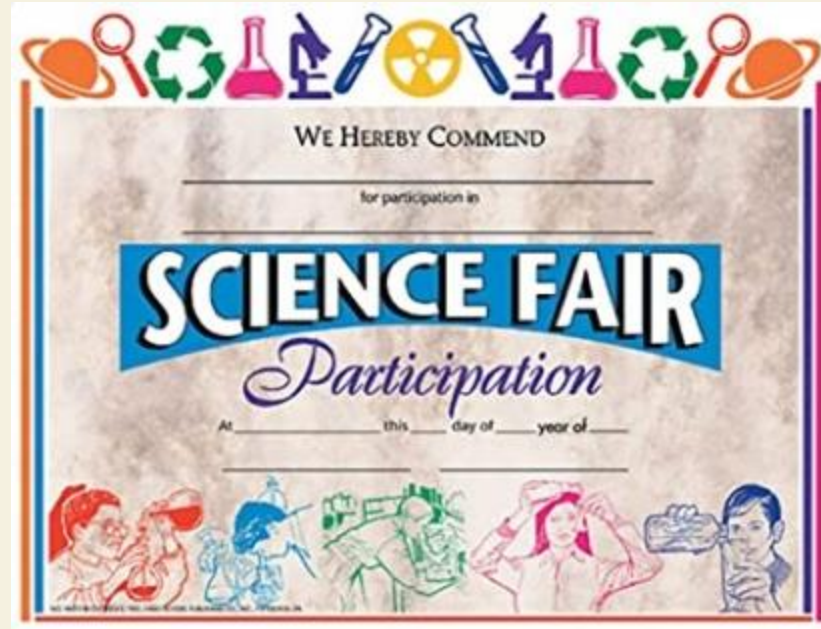

***“ALAMEDA COUNTY, CA – Today the State announced that Alameda County has met the metrics for the **Red Tier** for two weeks, and effective tomorrow, March 10, activities and businesses permitted in the Red Tier per the State’s Blueprint for a Safer Economy may resume operation. With an adjusted daily new case rate per 100,000 residents of 4.8, a testing positivity rate of 1.8 percent, and a health equity quartile positivity rate of 2.6 percent, the state of the pandemic has improved greatly in Alameda County since the peak of the winter surge in early January...”***

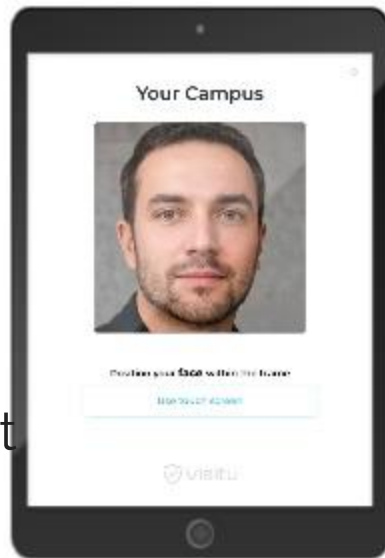

Visitor Pre-Registration 📅

Automatically assigned QR codes let visitors use a virtual digital badge from their phone for a touch-free and much quicker registration process.

- Students should have mask securely on face.

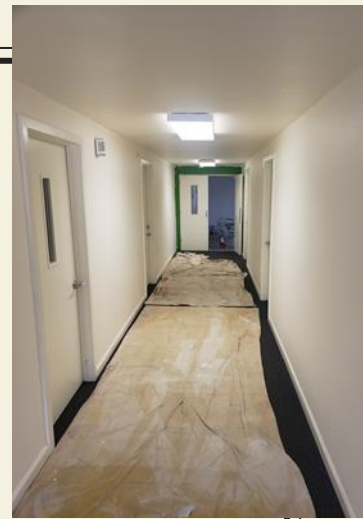

## Student Seating

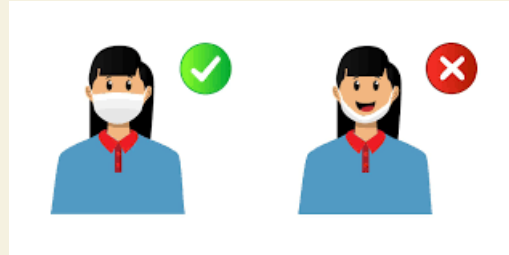
- Desk and tables will be used and separated a minimum of four feet for social distancing in a classroom and during lunch.
- Teachers will use desk / face shields when working with students. (Not a substitute for a face mask).
- Lap tops will be allowed on site to continue with online instructions.
- All areas will be sanitized throughout the day by staff and nightly by our cleaning company (Cintas).

Wearing a mask in Public may help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

### Here's how to wear it correctly



- Clean hands
- Holding the ear loops or ties, make sure it covers your nose and mouth and secure it around your chin.
- Make sure you can breathe easily and keep the mask the entire time while in public.
- Extra mask will be made available for students and staff on site.

## Break Time

- Only two students will be allowed in the restroom at any one time.
- Passes will be attached to the door to show how many people are in the restroom at one time.
- Water fountains will be disabled for the remainder of this year. Water bottles will be needed. The school will have extra water for those who needed it daily.
- Full lunch and a snack will be needed during break times.
- Schedules will remain the same as is online.

- Students will be brought to the entrance of the connection building with backpacks and other materials.
